

## Barna Mia Nocturnal Animal Sanctuary

The tour commences from Barna Mia at **6.15pm (August Only)** and concludes around 7.45 - 8.15pm. Sandwich board signs will be placed on Tomingley Rd (near Marri Road) approx. 30 minutes before the commencement of the tour to help with directions. If you are entering Dryandra Woodland from the main entrance on the Wandering/Narrogin road, follow the signs to the Lions Village and then continue to head west on Tomingley Rd until you come across the sandwich boards mentioned above. Barna Mia is not signposted during the day as the animals are sleeping and we do not wish for them to be disturbed.

**PLEASE ALLOW APPROXIMATELY 20 MINUTES TO DRIVE FROM THE LIONS DRYANDRA VILLAGE TO BARNA MIA**

### Things participants need to know:

Smoking and consuming alcohol **are not** permitted during the tour.

Flash photography is also not allowed as it may disturb the animals.

Due to the nature of the tour and sensitivity of the animals, Barna Mia is not recommended for children under 5 years of age. However, if you wish to bring young children, please ensure that they do not affect the enjoyment of other visitors.

For your safety please ensure all participants wear closed shoes and dress appropriately during the different seasons as it can be hot in summer and extremely cold in cooler months.

Merchandise and souvenirs are available (should you wish to take a memento of your experience with you) and there are credit card facilities at Barna Mia if that is your preferred method of payment for the tour.

- Tours run Monday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday for the general public. For groups of 20 PAX or more tours are available any day of the week, subject to availability and staff.
